HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY

Today, is Mother's Day. This is a holiday recognized and celebrated in the United States, yet many do not realize that it is both ancient and modern. Long before the modern holiday, many cultures held festivals honoring mothers and grandmothers; such as, the ancient Greeks, the Romans, and even in medieval England. The modern American version began largely through the efforts of Anna Jarvis in the early 1900s. After her mother, Ann Jarvis, died in 1905, Anna wanted a national day to honor the sacrifices mothers made for their children. In 1908 Ann organized one of the first official Mother's Day observances at a church in Grafton, WV. Her campaign spread quickly and by 1914 President Woodrow Wilson officially proclaimed the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day in the USA. Ironically, Anna later became upset that the holiday became heavily commercialized. She believed it should remain a personal day of gratitude rather than a business-driven celebration. Today, Mother's Day is celebrated in many countries around the world, though the dates and tradition vary. In the US, it remains one of the biggest days for: phone calls, church attendance, flower sales, and restaurant dining. So, today, let us celebrate our mothers and grandmothers for all the sacrifices they have made for us. Happy Mother's Day!
