LIFE IN RESURRECTION

Last week, the bulletin article dealt with the certainty of death and the reason behind death. We know that death is a reality for us all. However, let us now turn the page to a different way of seeing death. As many of you may know, in the South, watermelon is a delicacy. On a hot Summer day, to sit under the shade of a large tree and eat a sweet watermelon is awesome. However, if you did not know, in order for that watermelon to be produced, the seed that first grew the watermelon vine had to die. I remember as a young child, my grandmother would set her seeds in the windowsill and “dry” them out. The next year an old dried up seed would be placed in the dirt and once the essential elements touched it (water, air, the soil nutrients, etc.) the seed would begin to grow. From death came life. How it is for us all. We will one day sow this mortal body into the dirt, and our spirit will go to be with the Lord (2 Cor. 5:8). Yet, one day in the future the trumpet of God will sound and the dead in Christ will rise (1 Thess. 4). In other words, death will give way to life - eternal and glorified. Remember the words of Paul when he says, “So, will it be with the resurrection of the dead. The body that is sown is perishable, it is raised imperishable; it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body” (1 Cor. 15:42-43).
