"THE 3,000"

Pentecost was the birth of the church. It was a glorious day of Heaven's power being put on full display on Earth. As Peter stood to preach the life-giving message of the Gospel, 3,000 souls were saved. It was a day that Heaven rejoiced and angels sang the praises of God. Yet, on that very day, over a century earlier, Moses stepped into the presence of God on Mt. Sinai and received the Torah (Law). After communing with God for 40 days and 40 nights, Moses came down from the Mount to discover that the Children of Israel had made a golden calf. Upon chastising Aaron and the priests, Moses took a stand. At that moment, Moses ordered an examination of the camp. Unfortunately, 3,000 people were killed on account of their rebellion and lack of following the Torah (Law) of God. Today, we reflect on that moment of history. After the Law was given, 3,000 perished; yet, after Grace was given at Pentecost, 3,000 were saved. Take note of the beauty of God's plan. Truly, the Law is precious and needed. Yet, we cannot fully appreciate nor live the Law as we should. On the day of Pentecost, grace was dispensed and what we could not do; grace did. Grace made it possible for us to live the Law. Today, if we fail, the Law does not sentence us to death; rather, grace says, get back up and try it again. Praise God for GRACE!
