THE POWER OF LETTING GO

PASTOR ANDY KINDER

When you read in the book of Exodus 2 about Jochebed's trial, we see a mother that is being challenged to let go of her most precious possession. The story begins with Egypt's hatred for the Hebrews. Pharaoh orders the killing of all babies under the age of two. For three months Jochebed lives in horror. She hides Moses and prays that no one ever finds him. Yet something must have changed. She ends up building a small basket and waterproofs it. The very Nile River that the other boys were being thrown into, she had to release her baby boy into. The irony was that Moses' salvation came through a mother's sacrifice. Her ability to let go released him into the arms of God. In her way of thinking, releasing him may have delayed his death or maybe some traveler would find him. But God's purposes are greater than ours. Through this one act of sacrificial love, God allowed this baby to float into the arms of royalty (Pharaoh's daughter) and from this encounter comes the salvation of an entire nation – millions of people. At one of the greatest dilemmas of history for the Hebrews, God brings an unexpected salvation. The salvation of the nation came from a mother learning to let go. God moves in unexpected ways. So, today – will you let go and let God?
