## BAPTISM

Baptism is one of the greatest acts that a Christian can do. I love the story of the Ethiopian eunuch and the deacon Phillip in Acts 8. We read how the Ethiopian was reading the scripture and was completely baffled at what the Lord meant. Phillip comes alongside the caravan and begins to explain to the Ethiopian what the scripture meant, who the Messiah was, and the identity of Jesus. This transformed the Ethiopian. He received Christ and his entire life was different. Many scholars believe that from this one man's conversion came the Coptic Christians of northern Africa. Can you believe that one man that we don't even know his name was used in such an amazing way! The coolest part of this scripture is when Phillip asks to baptize the Ethiopian, he consents, and goes down into the water. Truthfully, it's not how he, you or I go down to the water, it is how we leave the water. As we celebrate baptism, we must recognize the overwhelming change that should be present. No, baptism does not save us. However, by baptism we relate with and join in the death and resurrection of our savior. Every baptism is a time to celebrate new spiritual life in the Lord. It is the baby dedication, so to say, for the new believer. Saying back to our great God that we are saved by the sacrifice of His only Son, Jesus and we align with Him. This Christian act serves to tie us back to the Old Testament, as well. The time when the priests would prepare to offer the temple sacrifice, they would go to the laver and wash. This was symbolic of cleansing their sins as they prepared to serve God. So, as we prepare to serve Jesus with our whole lives, may we be "washed by the water" as we commit ourselves to Jesus.
